The Academy will use at least 50% of Student Wellness and Success Funds for mental health services, physical healthcare services, or a combination of contracting with outside agencies to provide counseling and other services to our students and hiring mental health professionals.

During the 2023-2024 school year, Columbus Bilingual Academy North has partnered with The National Youth Advocate Program (NYAP) and the Columbus Public Health Department's Alcohol and Drug Services (YES and SUCCESS). These partnerships have been crucial for our school as they provide essential services for our students in the areas of mental health prevention and treatment, individual and group counseling, and drug and alcohol addiction prevention, among others.

Utilizing the Student Wellness and Success funds will significantly impact our students by addressing crucial aspects of their well-being, particularly in the realms of social and emotional health. With the challenges posed by the ongoing pandemic, there has been a heightened awareness of the importance of mental health and emotional resilience among students. By allocating these funds effectively, we can implement initiatives and programs to enhance our student body's overall well-being. We expect to see a 5-10% decrease in disruptive student behavior year over year.
