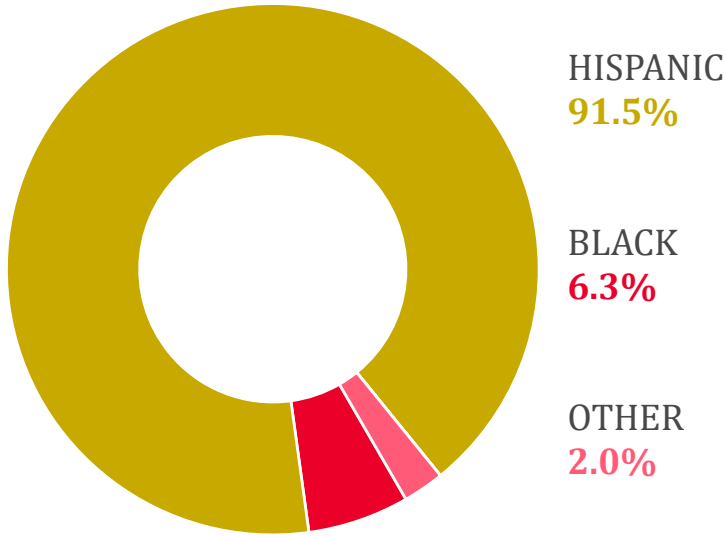

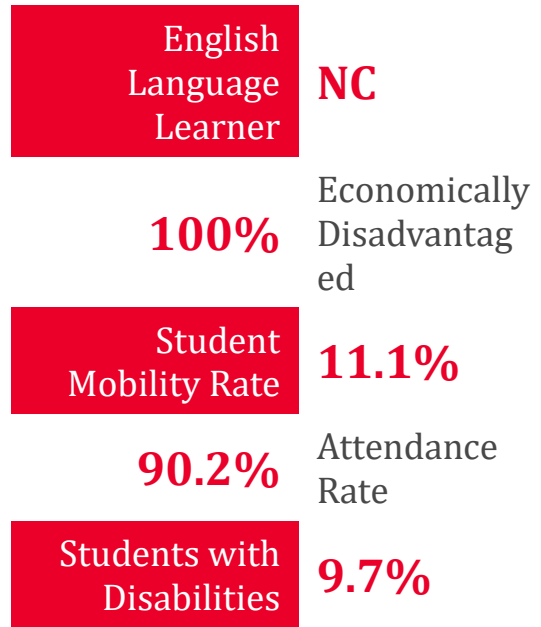

Progress towards Goals

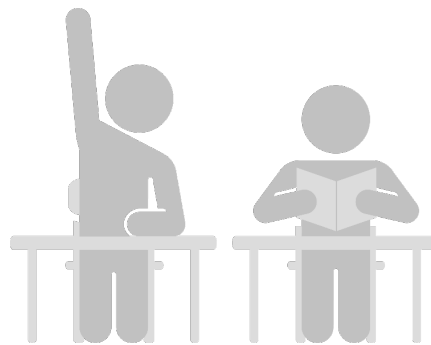

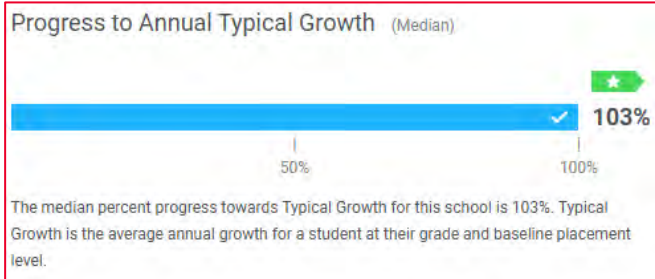

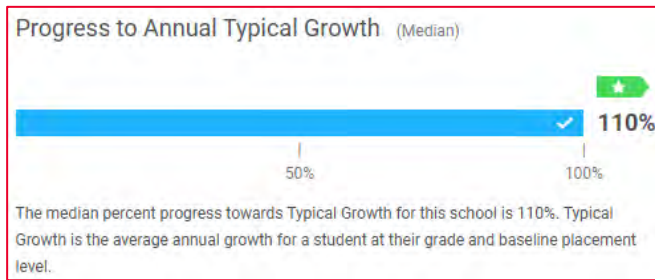

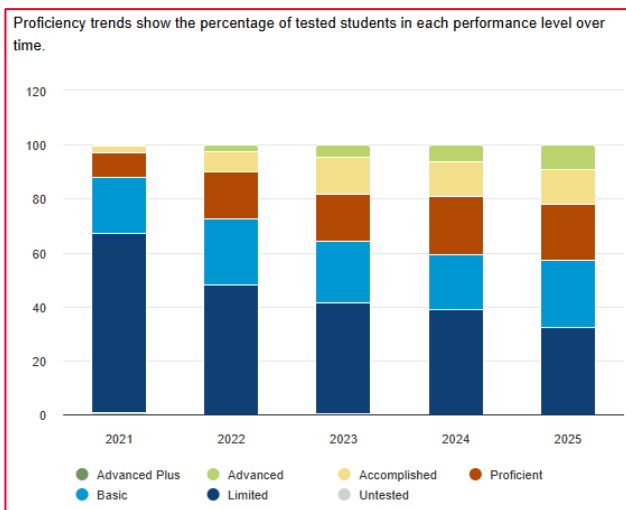
iReady Data Reading
